

2020 Candidate Reporting Dates

Below is the campaign treasurer reporting calendar for 2020 candidates who file with the Nassau County Supervisor of Elections. Campaign treasurer reports must be electronically filed through the Supervisor of Elections' website (www.VoteNassau.com) using the C-Finance module no later than Midnight (Eastern Time) of the reporting due date as required by law or the reports are deemed filed late and are subject to the applicable penalties pursuant to Florida Statute 106.07.

Each candidate who withdraws his or her candidacy, becomes an unopposed candidate, or is eliminated as a candidate or elected to office shall, within 90 days, dispose of campaign funds in the campaign account and file a Termination Report (TR) with the Supervisor of Elections.

Note: The report must list the name, address, and occupation of the person making the contribution; however, the occupation need not be listed if the aggregate contribution from the person is \$100 or less.

Penalty for Late Filing

Any candidate or committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding an election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For Termination Reports the fine is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. *Candidates must dispose of all funds in the campaign account and file a Termination Report within 90 days after having withdrawn, becoming unopposed, eliminated or elected to office.*
