THREE WAYS TO VOTE

VOTE BY MAIL

Ballots may be requested through two regularly scheduled general elections in writing, in person, by phone, fax, mail, email or [click here](#). Your name, residence address, date of birth and signature or mark (written requests only) must be provided when making the request. If the ballot requested is to be mailed to an address other than the voter's address on file, the request must be made in writing and signed by the voter (except for absent uniformed service or overseas voters).

VOTE ON ELECTION DAY

On Election Day, voters must vote at their assigned polling place.

Polling places are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you do not know your precinct and polling place location, please refer to your Voter Information Card, [click here](#) or call our office. Please be advised that it is against the law to knowingly vote outside of the precinct in which you live.

WHEN VOTING IN PERSON

Please remember to bring your photo and signature identification with you to the early voting site or your assigned polling place on Election Day. If you do not present the proper identification, you will be allowed to vote a provisional ballot. Voter Information Cards **may not** be used for identification. [Click here](#) for a list of acceptable identification.

All early voting sites and polling places are accessible to persons with disabilities and are equipped with accessible voting equipment with an audio ballot feature. Voting assistance is available to any voter who requires assistance to vote. The voter may request the assistance of two election officials or another person of their own choice to assist them in casting their vote. Persons with disabilities requiring accommodations in order to participate in the election process should contact our office prior to voting.
