Penalty for Late Filing

Any candidate or committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding an election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

For Termination Reports the fine is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. **Candidates must dispose of all funds in the campaign account and file a Termination Report within 90 days after having withdrawn, becoming unopposed, eliminated or elected to office.**
